When was the H.I.K.E. Fund started?

In Canada it was started in 1990, In the United States in 1985 and in Australia in 1995

What types of equipment are the grants given for?

Closed captioning units for televisions, tactile units. FM systems for schools, hearing aids, TDD telephones, computer equipment, and other technical devices

Who can apply for a grant?

Any hearing impaired person under the age of twenty with a financial need

How does a person apply?
